- Q. What information can I find for each type of organization?
- A. As available or shared by the organization, all profiles include company name, company type, company logo, description, team contact names/titles, address, and website URL. As available or shared by the organization, the following information is also provided based on organization type:

- Q. How often is the guide updated?

- Q. If my organization is listed in the guide, can I request that it be removed?
- A. Yes, you are able to completely opt out of being listed in the guide or you may choose share only specific information about your organization. Please contact <u>Susan Renno</u>, MVCA Project Coordinator, for any special requests.
- Q. How will I know if someone messages my organization via the contact feature in the portal?
- A. Messages sent through the portal can be recognized by their subject line, which starts with "MVCA Referral."



ACCESS & NAVIGATION TIPS

From the MVCA Home Page, go to Resources and click Landscape Guide from the drop-down menu.



• Use the search feature to find organizations by type, sector, stage, name, and/or city.



- A maximum of three (3) search criteria is ideal.
- For drop-downs, a maximum of one (1) criterion can be selected.
- Text fields (Organization Name and City) are <u>not</u> casesensitive.
- Manually clear or change your search criteria as needed.
 Refreshing your browser will not clear search criteria.



- If an organization's profile includes a blue contact button, you may message the organization directly from the portal.
 - 1 To send a message, click Contact.
 - 2 Complete the form (all fields are required) and click <u>Send</u>. <u>Prior</u> to clicking <u>Send</u>, you may cancel the message and close the form by clicking the <u>Exit Button</u> (X).
